ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF POSITION

Purpose

A Tutor in Tourism and Hospitality Management is expected to make contributions to the teaching effort of the institution, particularly at undergraduate level and carry out activities to develop his/her scholarly research and/or professional expertise relevant to the tourism and hospitality profession or discipline.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

1. **Teaching**

- 1.1 Conduct tutorial sessions to assist students in understanding course materials. answering questions, and clarifying concepts related to Tourism and Hospitality Management:
- 1.2 Collaborate with course coordinators to develop and implement effective teaching strategies and materials that enhance student learning experiences.
- 1.3 Provide one-on-one or small group tutoring sessions to address specific student needs and challenges:
- Assist students in developing effective study skills and time management 1.4 techniques;
- 1.5 Assists in marking students' assessments for the course/s tutored.

2. Research

- 2.1 Preparation for higher studies:
- 2.2 Learning and research methods;
- 2.3 Work as research assistant.

3. Administration

- 3.1 Participation in course administration;
- 3.2 Limited participation in school level committee meeting.

4. Outreach

- 4.1 Supporting student extra curricular activities;
- 4.2 Services to the Division, School and University community.

5. Distance Education

- 5.1 Attending consultation with external students through e-mail;
- 5.2 Marking and assessment

Qualification Requirement: Skill Base
